How Deal with Robbery

In the event the restaurant is robbed, the following must be done:

Cooperate with the demands of an armed robber. Any person committing an armed robbery is under great tension and may be under the influence of alcohol or narcotics. No team member should say or do anything that will increase this tension. Assume the robber has a weapon, even if nothing displayed.

DO NOT TRY TO BE A HERO! GIVE up cash or any other items that the robber demands. There should be no resistance or attempt to deceive the robber concerning the amount or location of what is asked for during the robbery. At the same time, do not volunteer information.

ALL witnesses should observe the physical characteristics and clothing of the robber (s).

IMMEDIATELY after the robber has departed, dial 911 to alert the local police. Each witness must complete an incident.
